



INMATE VISITATION HOURS

All visitors must be checked in one half hour before visitation hours are over.

Every visitor who is 16 years old or older must show a valid photo ID.

Effective March 1, 2018, a parent or legal guardian must accompany their child 16 years of age or under and provide a birth certificate, social security card or legal documentation for the child. Once documentation has been provided and logged into our system, no documentation will be needed for the juvenile for future visitation for this inmate. When visiting a different inmate, documentation will need to be provided.

There is only one 30-minute visitation per day for each inmate. All visitors may go in to the visitation room together.

★ **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING.** *If you are found with an electronic device on your person, you will be told to leave immediately.*

★ **WE DO NOT ALLOW these items in the visitation rooms:**
 Purses, bags, book bags, food, drink cups, bottles or cans, jackets, coats, hoodies

★ **WE DO NOT ACCEPT**
 Newspapers, pictures, stamps, envelopes, "whites"*, cigarettes**, mail or cards***

*"Whites" include underclothes, shirts and socks. Writing materials and "whites" can be purchased on commissary.

**This is a non-smoking building.

***These items can be mailed; however, no packages are to be sent to an inmate unless authorized.

★ All cash must be deposited through the kiosk in the night lobby. Money can also be deposited on an inmate's account online and by telephone. Information is posted in both lobbies.

★ Religious materials, including Bibles, are accepted.

★ **No inappropriate dress shall be permitted in the Ashland County Jail.** The following are considered inappropriate:

tank tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps
 see-through, low-cut or provocative tops
 muscle T-shirts

bare midribs
 short shorts, skirts or dresses above mid-knee
 wording or pictures on clothing

★ *Please abide by these rules; if there is a problem, you will be asked to leave.*
